 - o Be sure to include your email address
 - If your employer needs your account information, you will need to provide them with the information below:

 - Your HSA account number is located at the bottom of the Profile tab of your home page (after your account is open)

AFTER COMPLETING YOUR ENROLLMENT:

- Activate your HSA Debit Mastercard® from your primary phone number when it arrives

ONCE YOUR ACCOUNT IS ACTIVATED:

- Manage your account online or on the mobile app: Make contributions and distributions, view statements and tax forms, upload receipts and much more
